The position is responsible for all facets and functions of the Police unit, including but not limited to, development for planning and budget, formulating policy, allocation of resources, supervision of staff, law enforcement discretion, as well as liaison with other law enforcement agencies, media, students, faculty and staff. The department plays an integral role in violence prevention, emergency management and enhancing public safety services

The successful candidate is expected to provide leadership in the performance of the responsibilities of the position in order to insure the success and credibility of the department's work and the reputations of the institutions involved as well as the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE). The position makes independent decisions regarding establishment of the appropriate level of protective services to ensure a safe and secure environment and must regulate the degree of protective services available to the institutions and their populations.
